# Academic Fees of the Rikkyo University for Academic Year 2024

We sincerely thank you for your continued understanding and support of our education and research.

Tuition for the 2024 academic year for current students will not be revised and will be the same as the tuition for the 2023 academic year. Research membership fees for graduate school will no longer be collected, while some of the experiment and practical training fees and research membership fees will be revised. Please check the attached table.

(Please note that tuition for newly-enrolled students (new first-year student) for the 2024 academic year will be raised by ¥50,000.)

During the 2023 academic year, COVID-19 was reclassified as Class 5 in the Infectious Disease Law. We have focused on our response to infections during the past three years as a university, and we have finally be able to return to normal operations thanks to the above action. At the same time, we were also able to develop online and on-demand classes and we gained knowledge through our COVID-19 response. We hope to operate the university utilizing this knowledge as the occasion may arise.

Rikkyo University was founded in 1874 as a school practicing education based on Christian values and will be celebrating its 150th anniversary in 2024. - 3) Experiment and practical training fees are fees for experiments, practical training, seminars, research, and orientation.
- 4) In the College of Science, students who do not take experiments as stipulated in the course guidebook or students who are studying abroad while enrolled at the university do not need to pay experiment and practical training fees. Similarly, the designated fee for each experiment discipline will be collected in addition from students who enrolled in all academic years in the Department of Physics, Chemistry, or Life Science and take laboratory disciplines outside of their assigned years (excluding cases stated at the start of Note 5).
- 5) In the Department of Physics, College of Science, students who choose Theoretical Physics as their graduation research 1 or 2 in the fourth year are not required to pay the experiment and practical training fees. In the Department of Physics, College of Science, students who take elective experiments (Physics Experiment 2) offered in the 3rd and 4th years will be charged 40,000 yen per course, and those who take elective experiments (Chemistry Experiment (Physics) and Biology Experiment (Physics) offered in the 2nd through 4th years will be charged 20,000 yen per course.
- 6) In the Department of Chemistry, College of Science, students who take elective experiments (Research Experiment 1, Research Experiment 2) offered in the 3rd and 4th year will be charged 40,000 yen per subject, Students who take Physics Experiment (Chemistry) will be charged 10,000 yen, and those who take Biology Experiment (Chemistry) will be charged 20,000 yen.
- 7) The College of Science, Department of Life Sciences will collect 10,000 yen for those who take Physics Experiment (Life Science) and 20,000 yen for those who take Chemistry Experiment (Life Science).
- 8) Students taking the Graduate Program in Primary Education, Department of Education, College of Arts, will be charged with experiment and practical training fees of 10,000 yen before graduation (usually in the third year).
- 9) Students who take Overseas Study Program in their second or third year in the College of Intercultural Communication will receive a tuition reduction for the year in which they take the program. The amount is shown in the "List of Tuition and Other Fees" for the year of study. The amount will be announced in the "Table of Rikkyo University academic fees and other payments" for the year of enrollment. However, the tuition reduction will not be applied to students who study abroad at partner universities.

- 10) The 50,000 yen lifetime membership fee of Rikkyo Alumni Association will be collected by proxy in the spring semester of the fourth year of enrollment. For students who enroll in September, the proxy fee will be collected in the fall semester of the fourth year of enrollment.

- 5) In the Department of Chemistry, College of Science, 40,000 yen will be charged for each elective experiment (Research Experiment 1, Research Experiment 2), 10,000 yen for each physics experiment (chemistry), and 20,000 yen for each biology experiment (chemistry) in the third and fourth year. The fee for those taking Physics Experiment (Chemistry) is 10,000 yen.
- 6) The College of Science, Department of Life Sciences will collect 10,000 yen for those who take Physics Experiment (Life Science) and 20,000 yen for those who take Chemistry Experiment (Life Science).
- 7) Students taking the Graduate Program in Primary Education, Department of Education, College of Arts, will be charged with experiment and practical training fees of 10,000 yen before graduation (usually in the third year).
- 8) Students enrolled in the College of Intercultural Communication for the 2019 academic year, the tuition fee is 839,000 yen for those who take the Overseas Study Program in the fourth year as a special exception due to the spread of the novel coronavirus infection. The tuition fee for those who do not take the Overseas Study Program is as above.
