



Dormitory Information For Special International Students

Rikkyo University offers special international students (including incoming exchange students from partner institutions) five dormitories in cooperation with external contractors by signing the rental contract. All the rooms of each dormitory are single and furnished so that you can start your life in Japan smoothly. Special international students are able to apply five dormitories as follows.

① RIR Shiinamachi ② RUID Asakadai ③ RUID Shiki ④ Rikkyo Global House ⑤ Comfort Ikebukuro

<< IMPORTANT >>

Please read the following conditions before applying for dormitories.

◎ Dormitory and room assignment

- Rikkyo University makes all decisions regarding dormitory and room assignments depending on the number of incoming exchange students. Although there are differences in the dormitory fee and facilities among five dormitories, only those who are willing to stay in any of the dormitories can apply for a room. **You cannot select or refuse any particular dormitory. Please note that your preference cannot be guaranteed due to the availability of rooms at each dormitory.**
- Once the housing arrangement is made by the university, you cannot change or cancel the accommodation. Therefore, you must read the information of the dormitories carefully and understand conditions completely before your application.

◎ Payment for the dormitory fee

- The dormitory fee will be charged **per semester**, and must be deposited directly into the designated bank account of the cooperated management company by the due date. Note that **installment payments are not allowed.** Therefore, please think well about how to bear the dormitory fee before applying for the dormitories.

◎ Change in Information

- The details of the dormitories such as the dormitory fee and facilities which are explained in this document are based on the information as of September 2018. Please note that they are subject to change in the future.

***The dormitory fee includes food service fee (breakfast and dinner), utility fee, Internet fee, security support fee and cleaning fee.**

*You are required to purchase a full meal plan (It is mandatory).

*Gas fee will be charged additionally (Approximately ¥4,000 per month).

*The dormitory fee will be revised due to the tax hike from October, 2019.

*If you wish to reside in the dormitory for one academic year, you are required to bear the additional dormitory fee as follows.

©When you continue to reside from spring semester to fall semester


The dormitory fee (approximately ¥620,000) for August to February (7 months) must be paid by the end of July.

©When you continue to reside from fall semester to spring semester

The dormitory fee (approximately ¥440,000) for March to July (5 months) must be paid by the end of February.

- Electricity fee ¥1,815 +usage fee (per month)
 - *Approximately ¥2,000 ~ ¥4,000 per month (including basic Electricity fee)
- Universal Service Fee ¥3 (per month/ subject to change)
- Meal Plan ¥17,100 (per month) <Optional>

*The electricity fee and other fees will be revised due to the tax hike from October, 2019.

*If you wish to reside in the dormitory for one academic year, you need to make a payment for the additional dormitory fee as follows.

©When you continue to reside from spring semester to fall semester


The dormitory fee (¥350,000) for August to February (7 months) must be paid by the end of July.

©When you continue to reside from fall semester to spring semester

The dormitory fee (¥250,000) for March to July (5 months) must be paid by the end of February.



***The dormitory fee includes utility fee, Internet fee and cleaning fee.** However, you will be charged for the amount of electricity that exceeds 100kWh per month.

*The dormitory fee is subject to be revised due to the tax hike from October, 2019.

*If you wish to reside in the dormitory for one academic year, you are required to make a payment for the

additional dormitory fee as follows.

©When you continue to reside from spring semester to fall semester

The dormitory fee (**¥210,000**) for August to February (7 months) must be paid by the end of July.

©When you continue to reside from fall semester to spring semester

The dormitory fee (**¥150,000**) for March to July (5 months) must be paid by the end of February.

5. COMFORT Ikebukuro

Comfort Ikebukuro is an apartment complex where other residents besides Rikkyo University students reside. We expect you to respect others and maintain good manners. Unlike the other dormitories, apartment manager is on duty only in the day time.

*You are also required to bear the cost as follows in addition to the dormitory fee.

- Utilities and internet fee ¥11,500 (per month)

If you move out of the apartment during the contract period, you will be charge the full amount of utilities and internet fee for the final month.

*The utilities and internet fee will be revised due to the tax hike from October, 2019.

*If you wish to reside in the dormitory for one academic year, you need to make a payment for the additional dormitory fee as follows.

©When you continue residing from spring semester to fall semester

The dormitory fee (~~¥420,000~~) for August to February (7 months) must be paid by the end of July.

©When you continue residing from fall semester to spring semester

The dormitory fee (~~¥300,000~~) for March to July (5 months) must be paid by the end of February.

■ Optional Services

◎ Bedclothes Leasing

Each dormitory except Comfort Ikebukuro offers bedclothes leasing as an optional service. Bedclothes leasing includes a comforter, a pillow, and a bed sheet. Bed sheets can be exchanged on a regular basis. Prior application is necessary for bedclothes leasing. After receipt of application, cancellation will not be accepted, and there will be no refund for cancellation. The fee will be revised from October, 2019.

Comfort Ikebukuro does not offer bedclothes leasing service. However, the management company will arrange a futon set (a comforter, a pillow, a thin mattress, a storage bag) with ¥7,500 for those who wish to purchase. Since this futon set is basic one, you may need to purchase an additional items such as a mattress if necessary.

◎ Meal Plan

The following dormitories serve meals as an optional service. The fee will be revised from October, 2019.

Meals are not served at both Rikkyo Global House and Comfort Ikebukuro. However, you can cook for yourself at the shared kitchen (Rikkyo Global House) or at your room (Comfort Ikebukuro).

■ Contract Period: In principle, you cannot move out during the contract period.

*Even If you move in to the dormitory after the contract period start, the dormitory fee and other fees will be charged from the contract start date.

*The contract start date differs every year.

* You cannot move out of the dormitory on Sundays or holidays. As for Comfort Ikebukuro, you cannot move out on Saturdays, Sundays or holidays.

■ Extension for the Dormitory Stay

If you wish to continue to reside in the dormitory after your contract ends, you can extend your stay up to the date indicated below. The dormitory fee and the other fees will be calculated on daily pro-rate. (Please keep in mind that you cannot move out on Sundays or national holidays. As for Comfort Ikebukuro, you cannot move out on Saturdays, Sundays or national holidays)

■ Renewal of Housing Contract

If you plan to study at Rikkyo for one academic year, and wish to continue to reside at the dormitory in the second semester, you must submit 'Continuation Notice' as well as the signed contract by the due date. Please note that the maximum period of residence shall be 11 months.

Spring (April) admission : early June

Fall (September) admission : early December

■ Resident Supporter

Every dormitory except Comfort Ikebukuro has students called 'resident supporter'. They reside in each each dormitory to help international students adjust to campus and life in Japan. Get to know your RS as they are your link to campus resources. Note Comfort Ikebukuro does not have RS.

■ Notes

1. The dormitory fee is charged per semester and must be deposited directly into the designated bank account of the cooperated management company by the due date. **In principal, installment payment is not allowed.**
2. Monthly charges such as utility bill, telephone/internet bill must be paid monthly by the due date through the designated way of the cooperated management company.
3. If you wish to extend their stay longer than the contract period, you are allowed to stay until the date designated on this document. The dormitory fee, electricity, telephone/internet and universal charges incurred during the period are calculated by the day.
4. Even if you do not stay at the dormitory for an entire month, housing expenses must be paid in full for the month.
5. In principle, you cannot move out of the dormitory in the middle of the contract period. However, if you submit a request for the termination of tenancy with a reasonable explanation, the International Office will review the case and may grant the permission for move out if deemed necessary. It is still your responsibility to pay the full amount of the dormitory fee for the entire term of the contract.

■ Major Rules and Regulations *Note: Rules and Regulations differ between the dormitories

- Each dormitory has furfew.

- Please lock the door whenever you leave your room.
 - Do not enter the floors or rooms of the opposite sex.
 - Please separate garbage following each dormitory's instruction.
 - Please notify the dormitory manager in advance if you wish to stay out for the night. (except for Comfort Ikebukuro)
 - Please have your meeting at the dining room when you have a visitor.
 - You are not allowed to smoke in the dormitory. You cannot even smoke in the balcony or entrance area. You will be charged for the cleaning of any wall discoloration caused by smoking.
 - Special International Students need to follow the instructions given by the International Office
- *There are other rules. Please carefully read the attached document "Dormitory Regulations".
