As of Oct. 2017

- (1) Students can apply for both scholarship No.1 and No.2. However, students can be granted only one of them.
- (2) Students who apply for the scholarship No.1 must submit the RUI application form with the application documents.
- (3) Rikkyo University does not fund scholarship No. 2 and No. 3. The information above is for 2017 for your reference. We will inform you about the details of both scholarships as soon as we receive the latest information for 2018.
- (4) Students who apply for the scholarship No.2 must submit the JASSO application forms to be sent in December/May.
- (5) The recipient of the scholarship No.3 is counted in the total number of applicants stated in the exchange agreement. The applicant for the scholarship No.3 must submit the for 'Monbukagakusho Scholarship' to be sent in early-November.

INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGE STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP 2018-19

(Dormitory Fee Waiver)

Rikkyo University offers above scholarship for the incoming exchange students coming from Rikkyo's inter-university partner institutions to enhance the successful academic collaboration.

Qualifications and Conditions

The intended applicants must meet the following criteria:

- (1) To be enrolled full-time in undergraduate or graduate programs at one of Rikkyo's inter-university partner universities and nominated by their home institution as an exchange candidate who will study in Rikkyo University as a Special International Student, starting in April or September 2018.
- (2) To be strongly interested in living at one of Rikkyo University's designated dormitories, Rikkyo University International Dormitory (RUID) Asakadai or Shiki, or Rikkyo Global House (RGH), and has no intention of moving out in the middle of the contract period.
- (3) To be ***not*** awarded with the Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO) International Student Scholarship or any other scholarship that offers the equivalent of 80,000 yen per month.

Since the number of scholarship awarded each year is based on limited funding, even those students who fulfill the above qualifications and conditions are not guaranteed to receive the scholarship.

Duration

The payment period ranges from 4 months to 11 months in accordance with students' period of stay at Rikkyo as well as the dormitory tenancy period.

Scholarship Details

Amount: equivalent of the monthly dormitory fee

**Note: The costs for optional meal plan, utilities and optional services are not included. There is no direct deposit of funds; it simply waives the payment of dormitory fee. Scholarship recipients lose the eligibility for the scholarship once they move out of the dormitory.*

Application Deadline and Instruction

Spring (April) 2018 admission: November 15, 2017

Fall (September) 2018 admission: March 31, 2018

The applicants need to complete the separate scholarship application form and attach it with the exchange program application. If the applicant's home university nominates more than one student to this scholarship, the authorized person of the applicant's home university needs to specify priorities on each applicant by filling in the "Priority order" on the application form.

While the students can apply for both the JASSO International Student Scholarship and dorm fee waiver, they can only receive either one of these scholarships if granted.

Notification of Scholarship Eligibility

Fall (September) 2018 admission: July 2018
