

Academic fees and other payments for the Academic Year 2015

Tuition Reduction Program for privately financed international students

Rikkyo University reduces the tuition of privately financed international students who have “College Student” resident status after enrollment and who face financial difficulty in pursuing university education, irrespective of the entrance examination system. Students who want to have their tuition reduced must submit an application every year. The International Office verifies whether each applicant is eligible by confirming their “College Student” resident status, and examines the necessity of tuition reduction by reviewing the applicant’s financial situation.

The reduced rate for 2015 is 35% of the tuition (rounded down to the nearest 100 yen). The program details and reduced rate are subject to change from year to year. Students who have exceeded the standard term of study, or those who are on leave from their studies, will not be eligible for tuition reduction. Adoption of a sliding scale

Tuition and education enhancement fee are subject to change from year to year, based on a sliding scale. We consider the inflation rate, improvement of education and research conditions, etc., when revising the slide rate. We adopt the Consumer Price Index (CPI) released by the Ministry of Internal Affairs as the inflation rate, and regard the inflation rate as 0% if the CPI is less than 0%. The sliding scale has been temporarily suspended.

Experiment and practical training fees are revised annually based on actual expenses.

1. The Department of Global Business of the College of Business offers Overseas EAP, a short-term overseas training course that generally must be taken by all students in their first year of study. The cost is 450,000–550,000 yen (actual rate in 2013) and is paid for separately from the student's academic fees and other payments. (The total cost is subject to change due to fluctuations in airfares and other related expenses). We offer a scholarship to students who have difficulty in paying the cost. Selected applicants receive 200,000 yen per person (for 30 students in 2013).

2. The Department of Intercultural Communication of the College of Intercultural Communication offers a class called Study Abroad Training, which must generally be taken by all students in the fall semester of their sophomore year. The cost is 670,000–1,580,000 yen (actual rate in 2013) and is paid for separately from the student's academic fees and other payments. (The cost includes the basic program fee, accommodation fee, etc., but airfare, and is subject to change due to exchange rate fluctuations and increases in fees charged by the destination university.) Students can choose a destination university from six language areas: English, German, French, Spanish, Chinese, and Korean. Students who take the Study Abroad Training will have the Tuition and Educational subsidy fee of the fall semester in the sophomore year reduced by 238,000 yen (actual rate in 2015) and have the opportunity to apply for the scholarship program (in 2013, 250,000 yen per person for 63 students).
