

Academic Fees of the Rikkyo University for Academic Year 2020

Let me take this opportunity to express my sincere gratitude for your continuing support of Rikkyo University's education and research.

We have been reviewing academic fees for the academic year 2020 and have decided to abolish educational enhancement fees, instead integrating them into tuition. Tuition will be revised with an increase of 50,000 yen for undergraduate students starting from the academic year 2020.

Integration of tuition and educational enhancement fees

At present, the university has set educational enhancement fees, experiment, and practical training fees as the items other than tuition among the academic fees excluding admission fees. Of these items, educational enhancement fees will be abolished and integrated into tuition.

The reason for this is that with the recently enacted laws related to "making higher education free of charge", the scope of the requirement is limited to tuition. In response to this enactment, we have decided that it is desirable to abolish educational enhancement fees and to integrate them into tuition.

Additionally, the number of international students is increasing in line with the internationalization of our university. Generally, it is often the case that a number of overseas institutions do not collect fees other than tuition, so it may be difficult to obtain understanding for this item called educational enhancement fees. For this reason as well, let me repeat that it is desirable to abolish the educational enhancement fees.

Details regarding revision of academic fees

(1) Undergraduates <Enrollments before the academic year 2019 (Undergraduates in their second year on)>

For the academic year 2020, we will abolish the above-mentioned educational enhancement fee, add the amount to tuition and integrate them. The tuition, however, will remain virtually unchanged (virtually the same amount as for the academic year 2019). Please refer to the attached table, as experiment and practical training fees will vary depending on the, college, department, and year of entrance.

(2) Undergraduates <Enrollments from the academic year 2020 (First year undergraduates)>

For students enrolling from the academic year 2020, the total unified tuition mentioned above will be increased by 50,000 yen. Admission fees will remain unchanged. Please refer to the attached table, as experiment and practical training fees will vary depending on the, college, department, and year of entrance.

(3) Graduate school

For graduate school tuition as well, we will abolish the above-mentioned educational enhancement fee, add the amount to tuition and integrate them. The tuition fee, however, will remain virtually unchanged (virtually the same amount as for the academic year 2019). Please refer to the attached table for Graduate School of Artificial Intelligence and Science and new courses in the Graduate School of Business (Graduate Program in Business), which will be launched in 2020.

Enhancement of major educational content and improvement of facility environments from the academic year 2020

We will celebrate the 150th anniversary of Rikkyo University in 2024. In November 2018, we established the "Basic Plan for Comprehensive Development (2018 - 2024)" as our mid- and long-term vision, and we are currently formulating an action plan to materialize the plan. The following are the main points leading to the enhancement of educational content and improvement of facility environments:

- Establishment of the Center for Foreign Language Education and Research and the subsequent improvement and sophistication of language education
- New development of specialized subjects in English in each department
- Improvement and sophistication of undergraduate education, including visualization of learning outcomes
- Assignment of personnel to all departments for internationalization to support the study abroad programs
- Further enhancement of the Rikkyo Minor Program
- Establishment of an environment for expanding the resources of the newly established Graduate School of Artificial Intelligence and Science into undergraduate education
- Establishment of a system for "visualizing" and "linking" social engagement education
- Continuation of Support Staff for Career Education assigned to all departments
- Strengthening career and employment support in response to changes in job searching
- Further promotion of campus IT, such as 100-minute class support and improved "Rikkyo Jikan"

- Large-scale campus development, including the construction of new buildings
- Development of infrastructure to realize the campuses with reduced disasters risks
- Establishment and reorganization of departments and faculties for the next era

Based on Rikkyo University's founding principles of “education based on Christian values”, we have nurtured each of our students, made progress in advanced research, and sincerely responded to the needs of the times over the past 140 years. Our society is entering a period of greater change than ever before, and likewise our responsibility to respond to the needs of the times is increasing. In order to fulfill this heavy responsibility, we will continue our efforts to continuously improve the quality of education while discovering intellectual creativity and new insights that will meet the needs of the next era.

Students who enrolled in academic year 2016 or later and are taking elective experiment disciplines assigned to third and fourth year students (Physics Experiment 2) will be charged 40,000 yen per discipline, and those who are in their third year or later and are taking Chemistry Experiment (Physics) or Biology Experiment (Physics), which are required subjects for second year students, will be charged 20,000 yen per discipline.
- 6) Students who enrolled in the Department of Chemistry, College of Science in academic year 2016 or later and are taking elective experiment disciplines assigned to third and fourth year students (Research Experiment 1, Research Experiment 2) will be charged 40,000 yen per discipline, and those who are taking Physics Experiment (Chemistry) or Biology Experiment (Chemistry) will be charged 20,000 yen per discipline.
- 7) Students who enrolled in the Department of Life Science, College of Science in academic year 2016 or later and are taking Physics Experiment (Life Science) or Chemistry Experiment (Life Science), which are required subjects for first year students, in their second year or later will be charged 20,000 yen per discipline.

Students who enrolled in academic year 2016 or later and are taking elective experiment disciplines assigned to third and fourth year students (Physics Experiment 2) will be charged 40,000 yen per discipline, and those who are in their third year or later and are taking Chemistry Experiment (Physics) or Biology Experiment (Physics), which are required subjects for second year students, will be charged 20,000 yen per discipline.
- 6) Students who enrolled in the Department of Chemistry, College of Science in academic year 2016 or later and are taking elective experiment disciplines assigned to third and fourth year students (Research Experiment 1, Research Experiment 2) will be charged 40,000 yen per discipline, and those who are taking Physics Experiment (Chemistry) or Biology Experiment (Chemistry) will be charged 20,000 yen per discipline.
- 7) Students who enrolled in the Department of Life Science, College of Science in academic year 2016 or later and are taking Physics Experiment (Life Science) or Chemistry Experiment (Life Science), which are required subjects for first year students, in their second year or later will be charged 20,000 yen per discipline.
- 8) Students taking the Graduate Program in Primary Education, Department of Education, College of Arts, will be charged with experiment and practical training fees of 10,000 yen before graduation (usually in the third year).
- 9) Students in the College of Intercultural Communication who are taking a study abroad program in the fall semester of their second year or third year will be charged tuition of 839,000 yen. Please note that tuition for students who do not take a study abroad program will be as listed in the table above.
- 10) The 50,000 yen lifetime membership fee of Rikkyo Alumni Association will be collected by proxy in the spring semester of the fourth year of study. Please note that this will be collected by proxy in the fall semester of the fourth year of study for students who enrolled in September.
