

Academic Fees of the Rikkyo University for Academic Year 2023

We would like to express our sincere gratitude for your continued understanding and support regarding our education and research.

This is to inform you that admission fee and tuition fee for the academic year 2023 will be the same as for the academic year 2022, without any revisions. Please note that there will be some changes to the experiment and practical training fees and research membership fee, so please refer to the attached tables.

Since the beginning of academic year 2022, the impact of COVID-19 that began in 2020 has been gradually subsiding, but the situation remains difficult both within and outside the country. Our education and research activities at the university were also constantly forced to keep a close eye on the situation of the infection. In this situation, Rikkyo University have tried to protect the lives and health of our students and to provide them with opportunities for learning and research by offering mainly face-to-face classes, and when necessary, online, on-demand, and a mix of face-to-face classes that are simultaneously delivered online.

Rikkyo University has and will continue to give top priority to protecting the health and lives of our students, offering a "post-Corona" version of the university and will provide a higher quality of education. We will continue to take the opinions of students and parents seriously to show the new way of Rikkyo University.

- Students who enrolled in the Department of Physics, College of Science in academic year 2016 or later and choose theoretical physics for their fourth-year graduation research project 1 and 2 do not need to pay experiment and practical training fees. In addition, students who enrolled in academic year 2016 or later and are taking elective experiment disciplines assigned to third and fourth year students (Physics Experiment 2) will be charged 40,000 yen per discipline, and those who are in their third year or later and are taking Chemistry Experiment (Physics) or Biology

- Experiment (Physics), which are required subjects for second year students, will be charged 20,000 yen per discipline.
- 6) Students who enrolled in the Department of Chemistry, College of Science in academic year 2016 or later and are taking elective experiment disciplines assigned to third and fourth year students (Research Experiment 1, Research Experiment 2) will be charged 40,000 yen per discipline, those who are taking Physics Experiment (Chemistry) will be charged 10,000 yen per discipline, and Biology Experiment (Chemistry) will be charged 20,000 yen per discipline.
 - 7) Students who enrolled in the Department of Life Science, College of Science in academic year 2016 or later and are taking Physics Experiment (Life Science), which are required subjects for first year students, in their second year or later will be charged 10,000 yen per year of study, and are taking Chemistry Experiment (Life Science) in their second year or later will be charged 20,000 yen per year of study.
 - 8) Students taking the Graduate Program in Primary Education, Department of Education, College of Arts, will be charged with experiment and practical training fees of 10,000 yen before graduation (usually in the third year).
 - 9) Students in the College of Intercultural Communication who are taking the Overseas Study Program in their second year will be reduced to 889,000 yen in tuition fees. However, the reduction of fees is not applied to students who study abroad at inter-university school. For those who do not take the Overseas Study Program, tuition fees are as above.
 - 10) In academic year 2023, the current Department of Sport and Wellness, College of Community and Human Services will be reorganized to form the College of Sport and Wellness. In accordance with this change, the Department of Sport and Wellness, College of Community and Human Services will stop accepting applications from the academic year 2023.
 - 11) The 50,000 yen lifetime membership fee of Rikkyo Alumni Association will be collected by proxy in the spring semester of the fourth year of enrollment. For students who enroll in September, the proxy fee will be collected in the fall semester of the fourth year of enrollment.

- 6) Students who enrolled in the Department of Life Science, College of Science in academic year 2016 or later and are taking Physics Experiment (Life Science), which are required subjects for first year students, in their second year or later will be charged 10,000 yen per year of study, and are taking Chemistry Experiment (Life Science) in their second year or later will be charged 20,000 yen per year of study.
- 7) Students taking the Graduate Program in Primary Education, Department of Education, College of Arts, will be charged with experiment and practical training fees of 10,000 yen before graduation (usually in the third year).

- 8) Students in the College of Intercultural Communication, the tuition fee is 889,000 yen for those who take the Overseas Study Program in the third year, or in the fourth year as a special exception concerning the spread of the novel coronavirus infections. The tuition fee for those who do not take the Overseas Study Program is as above.
- 9) The 50,000 yen lifetime membership fee of Rikkyo Alumni Association will be collected by proxy in the spring semester of the fourth year of enrollment.-For students who enroll in September, the proxy fee will be collected in the fall semester of the fourth year of enrollment.

- 5) Students who enrolled in the Department of Chemistry, College of Science in academic year 2016 or later and are taking elective experiment disciplines assigned to third and fourth year students (Research Experiment 1, Research Experiment 2) will be charged 40,000 yen per discipline, and those who are taking Physics Experiment (Chemistry) will be charged 10,000 yen per discipline, and Biology Experiment (Chemistry) will be charged 20,000 yen per discipline.
- 6) Students who enrolled in the Department of Life Science, College of Science in academic year 2016 or later and are taking Physics Experiment (Life Science), which are required subjects for first year students, in their second year or later will be charged 10,000 yen per year of study, and are taking Chemistry Experiment (Life Science) in their second year or later will be charged 20,000 yen per year of study.
