- 5) Students who take the Comprehensive Science Experiments in the 2nd through 4th years will be charged 20,000 yen.
- 6) In the Department of Physics, College of Science, students who choose Theoretical Physics as their graduation research 1 or 2 in the fourth year are not required to pay the experiment and practical training fees. In the Department of Physics, College of Science, students who take elective experiments (Physics Experiment 2) offered in the 3rd and 4th years will be charged 40,000 yen per course, and those who take experiments (Chemistry Experiment (Physics) and Biology Experiment (Physics) offered in the 2nd through 4th years will be charged 20,000 yen per course.
- 7) In the Department of Chemistry, College of Science, students who take elective experiments (Research Experiment 1, Research Experiment 2) offered in the 3rd and 4th year will be charged 40,000 yen per subject.
- 8) The College of Science, Department of Life Sciences will collect 10,000 yen for those who take Physics Experiment (Life Science) and 20,000 yen for those who take Chemistry Experiment (Life Science).
- 9) Students taking the Graduate Program in Primary Education, Department of Education, College of Arts, will be charged with experiment and practical training fees of 10,000 yen before graduation (usually in the third year).
- 10) Students in the College of Intercultural Communication, the tuition fee is 939,000 yen for those who take the Overseas Study Program in the second or third year. However, the tuition reduction will not be applied to students who study abroad at university-wide agreement. The tuition fee for those who do not take the Overseas Study Program is as above. Tuition fees for students enrolling in the 2026 academic year who take the Study Abroad Program in the 2027 academic year or later will be announced in the “List of Tuition and Other Fees” for the academic year in which the program is to be taken.
- 11) The 50,000 yen lifetime membership fee of Rikkyo Alumni Association will be collected by proxy in the spring semester of the fourth year of enrollment. For students who enroll in September, the proxy fee will be collected in the fall semester of the fourth year of enrollment.

- 6) In the Department of Chemistry, College of Science, students who take elective experiments (Research Experiment 1, Research Experiment 2) offered in the 3rd and 4th year will be charged 40,000 yen per subject.
- 7) The College of Science, Department of Life Sciences will collect 10,000 yen for those who take Physics Experiment (Life Science) and 20,000 yen for those who take Chemistry Experiment (Life Science).
- 8) Students taking the Graduate Program in Primary Education, Department of Education, College of Arts, will be charged with experiment and practical training fees of 10,000 yen before graduation (usually in the third year).
- 9) Students enrolled in the College of Intercultural Communication for the 2019 academic year, the tuition fee is 839,000 yen for those who take the Overseas Study Program in the fourth year as a special exception due to the spread of the novel coronavirus infection. The tuition fee for those who do not take the Overseas Study Program is as above.
